## Alliance member staff awarded scholarships to complete Certificate in Aging program

New Age of Aging partnership offers support for continued education

Eighty-six scholarships were awarded to staff, interns, and volunteers at 35 Alliance member organizations, as well as eight Alliance staff, so that they may receive a [Certificate in Aging](#). This professional development opportunity is available through the Alliance's [New Age of Aging](#) initiative, in collaboration with the Boston University School of Social Work's [Institute for Geriatric Social Work](#).

The Certificate in Aging program is valued at \$500 and includes 21 continuing education units (CEUs) for licensed professionals.

Recipients will be awarded their Certificate in Aging after completing five self-paced online courses. These courses provide participants with a core foundation of knowledge and skills in the field of aging.
